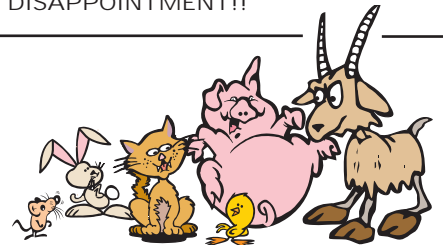
buffet for children and adults in the Wain House. This event will take place between noon and 4pm, Saturday 3rd and Sunday 4th December.
