**Payment is due in full upon arrival on the day of your trip by cash, credit/debit card or cheque (made payable to J & D Wainhouse please).**

**Cancellation Fee: Please note, if you cancel your booking with us a cancellation fee of £65 will be charged. However, no charge will be made if you need to rearrange the date of your visit - subject to availability. If you cancel within 3 weeks of the date of your trip, the full amount due will be payable. A booking made by you confirms acceptance of these terms.**

**Duration of visit** Min 2 hours, Max all day (during normal opening hours).

**Guided Tours:** We have two types of tours - times are allocated on arrival:

- The ***Baby Animal Tour*** is tailored for Nursery, Reception and Year 1 children. This is an engaging, interactive, fun and educational experience for the children lasting approximately 20 minutes facilitated by Farmer James and involves stroking and petting the animals. (Includes having a go at milking "Daisy" our life size model cow in our Autumn&Winter trip.)
- The ***Full Farm Tour*** is tailored for Key Stage 2 children and above. This is a fully facilitated guided tour around the farm visiting the different animals, where we discuss a range of issues related to animal husbandry and welfare with the children, including our milking parlour where children will learn about the milking process and wider issues related to farming. This tour lasts between 40 and 50 minutes depending on feedback and questions from the group which we encourage!

**Farmer James Fun Barn:** You can pre book a one hour play session for the children in our brilliant indoor Play Centre for £1 per child during our Low Season and £2 per child from 1 April 2012. (Children must be supervised by accompanying adults during these sessions.) Fun Barn sessions are during general opening hours.

**The Wain House Tea Room**, our 16<sup>th</sup> Century barn conversion, offers a wide range of freshly prepared meals, snacks and refreshments. Children's lunch boxes can be provided, if pre-ordered, at a cost of £3.25 each.

Separate, dedicated smaller **toilet facilities** for the convenience of younger children are available in addition to the other toilet facilities on the Farm.

**First Aid Facilities** are available. However, schools and groups should bring their own medical supplies with them on their visit.
